Portage Minor Hockey Scholarship Program

- **Any Student that was a member of PMHA for a majority of her/his minor hockey play is eligible for a PMHA Scholarship upon her/his graduating year. This would mean over 50% of the players minor hockey would have had to have been played with PMHA teams.**
- **The eligible player would only be entitled to the PMHA Scholarship if she/he is attending a Post Secondary Educational Program (University/College/Community College) and will be playing hockey within the Hockey Program of the post secondary institution she/he is registered at.**
- **Payment of the PMHA Scholarship will be made once proof of registration to the school and her/his verification of being on the team roster for that school. Submitted documentation from the Post Secondary Institution will be required by PMHA. (examples – formal registration receipts and letter from Hockey Program indicating involvement)**
- **PMHA will pay out up to \$1,000.00 per year in Scholarship Funding.**
- **All Players who meet the above requirements will be eligible. Players must submit in writing which post secondary school they will be attending and what PMHA meant to them over their time involved.**
- **The Yearly Scholarship Fund will be divided equally amongst the Applicants that PMHA selects based on the above criteria with no Applicant eligible to receive more than \$500.00. (example – if there are 5 total applicants – 3 Female and 2 Male then each would receive $\$200.00 = \$1,000.00$ – 2 total applicants would be $2 \times \$500.00 = \$1,000.00$)**
- **This is a one time Scholarship Opportunity paid to the Graduating player. The application for the PMHA Scholarship must be made within 12 months of graduation. Deadline for submission is October 31 of each year. Applicants will be notified of awards following the first meeting of the Board of Directors, following the deadline.**
